Re: Serious Medical Incident in School

I regret to inform you that this week there was a serious incident in school that required a student to receive medical attention. The cause of this is possibly linked to vaping. I am sure that you are aware that it is illegal for anyone under 18 to purchase vapes and the longterm medical impact of vaping is not yet fully understood. There is a great deal of information on vaping from ASH here: ASH resources on youth vaping - ASH

However, in recent months there has been a growing and significant risk from the illegal supply of vape fluid laced with THC cannabis oil and synthetic Spice. These cannot be purchased legally and are produced and distributed by criminals. This is a national problem and there have been many reports of young people suffering significant and very serious medical problems when using these fluids. For example: Teenage boy collapsed after one puff of vape bought in 'counterfeit capital' Cheetham Hill | ITV News Granada

There is a possibility that the incident at Handsworth Grange Community Sports College this week was caused by the use of these illegal fluids. It goes without saying that we are taking this possibility very seriously and we are working with many agencies, including South Yorkshire Police, The Corner, Sheffield 'Smokefree' and a range of wider safeguarding partners to ensure young people are safe and protected from the risk. All our students have attended an assembly, delivered by The Corner, to highlight the risk of buying and consuming illegal vape products. We have also held a range of information sessions for students, facilitated by The Corner and spent sessions in tutor and PHCSE lessons around the dangers surrounding vaping. We will continue to build this into our curriculum as we move into the next term.

When young people purchase and use THC or Spice vape oil they are being exploited by criminals, they are putting themselves at considerable medical risk and they are committing a criminal offence. If staff suspect that any student is carrying or using vapes on school premises, then we may need to search for it following the procedures as outlined on page 13 in our behaviour policy –

Any vape materials discovered will be confiscated and the student sanctioned appropriately including the consideration of suspension and even permanent exclusion. Should illegal substances be found then the student will also be reported to the police and in all instances parents or carers informed.
