Term 3 Enrichment Round Up

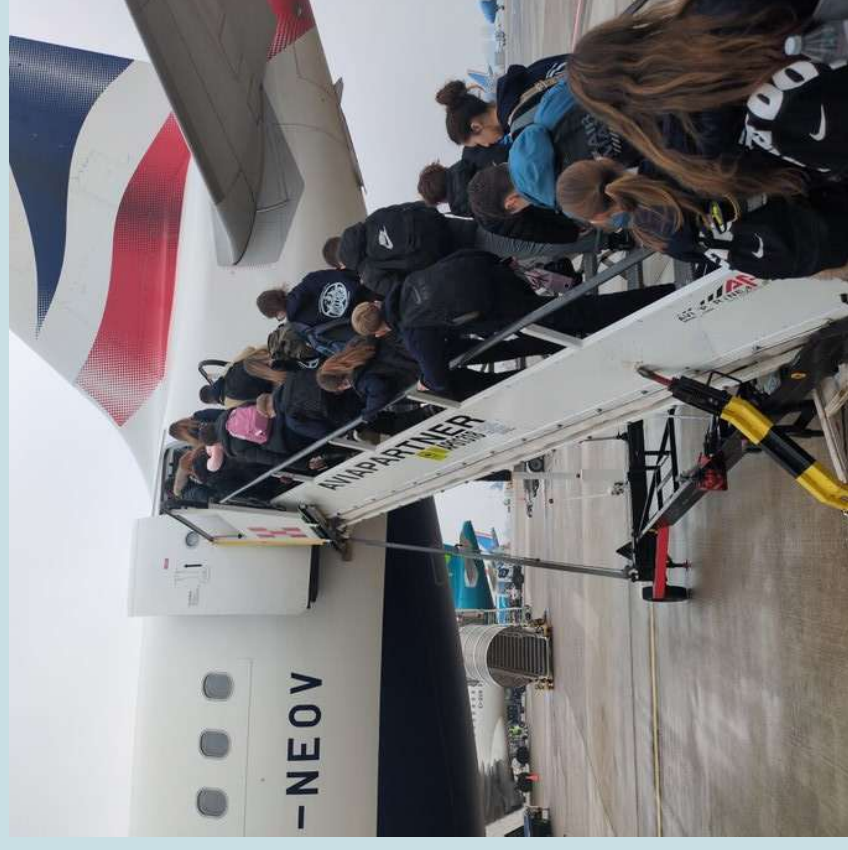

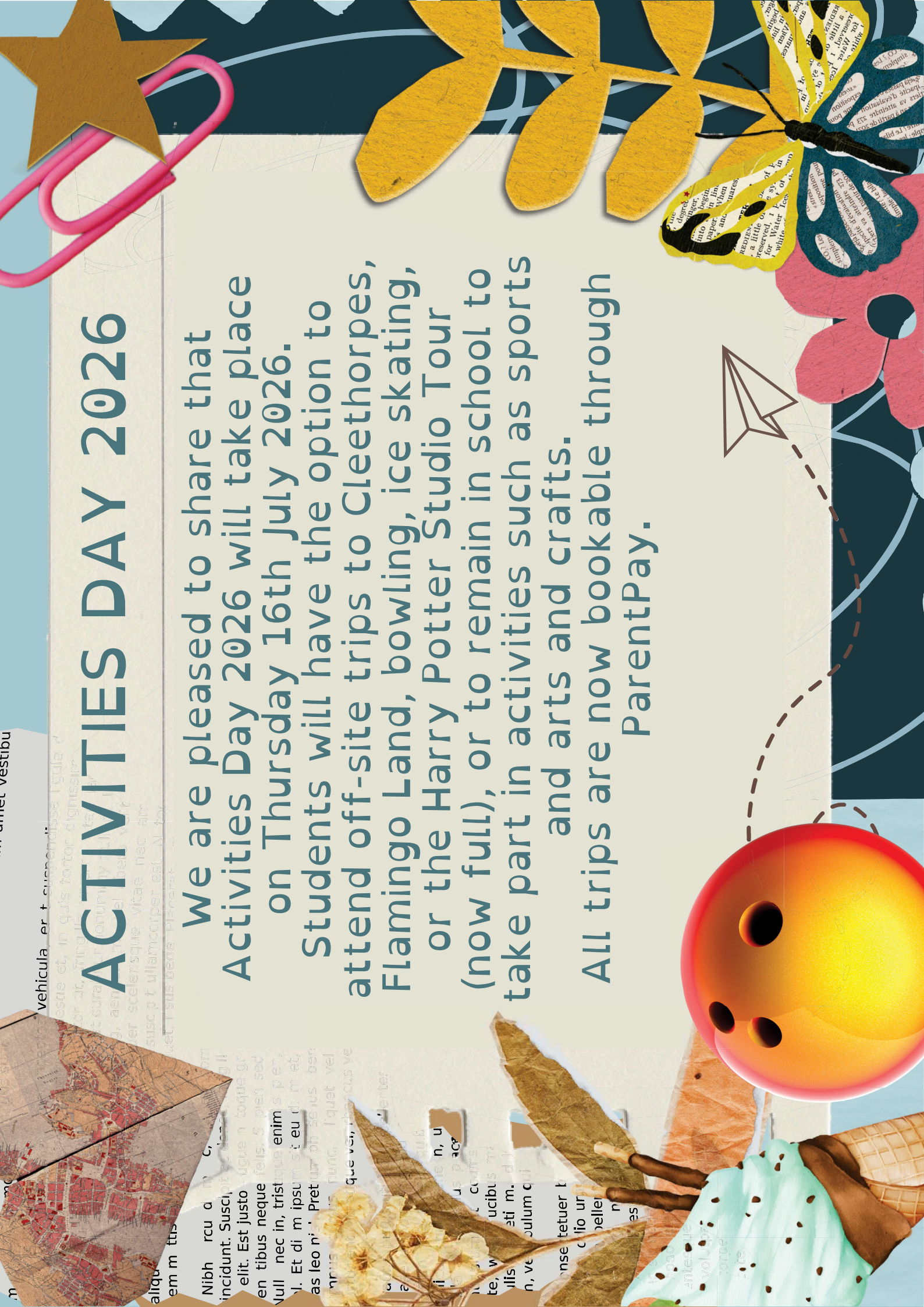

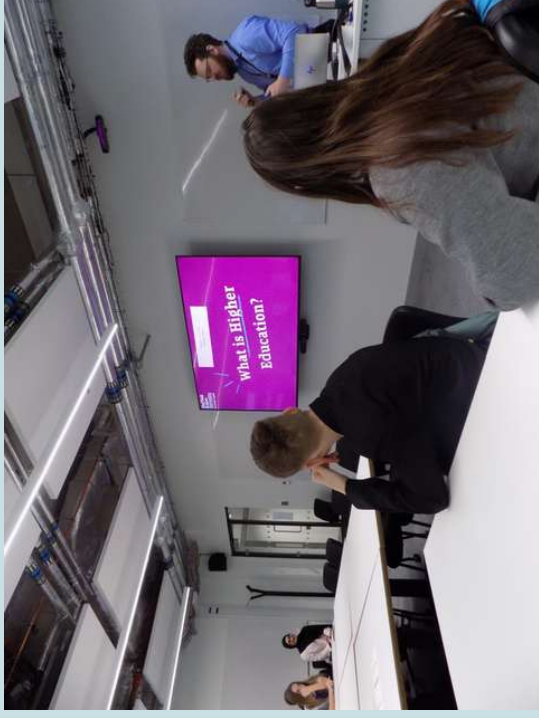
All trips are now bookable through ParentPay.

On Wednesday 21st January, Miss Jackson and Ms Bocking took 23 pupils from Y8 and Y9 to Sheffield Hallam University for a Languages Taster Day. Throughout the day, students took part in workshops in both French and Spanish, an engaging introduction to Higher Education, and a tour of the campus led by current university students.

The experience gave pupils a valuable insight into university life, the wide range of courses available, and the many ways that studying a language can help develop key skills and open doors to future opportunities. Students behaved exceptionally well, engaging enthusiastically in every session, asking thoughtful questions, and representing the school brilliantly.

Following the visit, many students reported that their interest in languages had increased, and that they felt more knowledgeable and confident about what university involves. Several who had not previously considered higher education as an option were, by the journey home, talking excitedly about how they could see themselves studying there in the future!
