**Re: Wearing of Face Coverings in Classrooms and Communal Areas**

Following the latest Government Guidance, from Monday 17 May 2021, all secondary age school children will no longer be required to wear a face covering inside classrooms and other communal areas within school.

However; if you feel you would still prefer your child to wear their face covering whilst inside classrooms and communal areas, we will support you in your decision.

We will continue to implement our Covid 19 safety control measures which will remain the same. This includes staggered start, lunch and finish times, and separate entrances and exits for our different year group bubbles.

Extra daytime cleaning, handwashing and social distancing measures including ventilation of rooms will still be a requirement.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your ongoing support and in encouraging your child(ren) to understand the importance of helping to keep the spread of the virus to a minimum and therefore our school a clean and safe place to learn.
