

Art Department summary of Assessment

Lesson Formative Assessment

- Live feedback is used in lessons for individuals and the class to address misconceptions and improve the quality of their work.
- Critique sessions where pupils work as a class, peer assessing each other's work allowing individuals time to then reflect and self-assess their own work.
- Learning logs at the end of each lesson where pupils can self-assess and reflect on their learning that lesson.
- Targeted questioning to ascertain individuals understanding.

Medium Term Summative Assessment

KS3

- Each project will have a 3D practical assessed piece of work that will be completed in non-assessment conditions
- At the end of each project pupils will be given an assessment drawing task to complete in assessment conditions.

KS4

- Pupils are given mini assessment activities each term based on observational drawing.
- Mock Exams in line with the whole school Mock exam timetable. Pupils will have 5 hours to produce their art piece in exam assessment conditions.

Final End of course Summative Assessment

End of Year 11 GCSE. This is a project that starts in the January of Y11. Assessment objective 1,2 and 3 are completed over a period of 3 months. Assessment objective 4, their personal response will be produced over 10 hours in exam conditions. Each assessment objective is weighted equally and the exam form 40% of their GCSE grade.
