Day-to-day Formative Assessments that could include: diagnostic assessments, low stakes topic tests, Low stakes quizzes, checks of homework activities, checks on written work in class, modelling with student self-checking, live-marking, exit passes.

REP + CaP + Assessment:

Formative assessment – every lesson retrieval starter task, exit ticket, short assessed pieces regularly and live marked (Outline, Describe, Explain, Describe, Evaluate) , knowledge quiz at the end of each topic

CaS Assessment:

Formative assessment – every lesson retrieval starter task, exit ticket, short assessed pieces regularly and live marked (Outline, Describe, Explain, Describe, Evaluate) , knowledge quiz at the end of each topic

GCSE Assessment:

Formative assessment – every lesson retrieval starter task, exit ticket, short assessed pieces live marked (Outline, Describe, Explain, Describe, Evaluate) fortnight , knowledge quiz at the end of each week

Medium Term Summative Assessments that could include: end of year assessments, mid-year assessments, baseline assessment, trial exams. There should be no more than three a year. Please indicate timings within the year and indicate differences between year groups. Please also include details of your moderation and standardisation of trial exams.

REP + CaP + Assessment:

Summative Assessment – Three topics per year extended written and oral assessed piece based on blooms taxonomy

CaS Assessment:

Mid topic Knowledge quiz
End of topic knowledge quiz

GCSE Assessment:

Mid topic GCSE paper + knowledge quiz
End of topic GCSE paper + knowledge quiz

Final End of Course Summative Assessments that could include: end of course GCSE and BTEC exams, modular exam, assessed coursework, assessed performances.
