Unit 2 Peace and Conflict	Students will know understand the concepts of peace and conflict Students will know and understand key issues of conflict resolution, when conflict is acceptable and resolution Student will know and understand common issues such as just war, holy war, reconciliation, and forgiveness Students know and understand alternative views and how ethical frameworks might impact on moral decisions Students will know and understand tier 3 vocabulary	Fluency test for vocabulary and key facts half way through the topic End of Unit exam focussing on vocabulary, key points of understanding and knowledge
Unit 3 Relationship ethics	Students will know understand the concepts of relationship ethics Students will know and understand key issues of love, marriage, divorce and the raising of children Student will know and understand common issues of changing roles of relationships, the place of the family in society and how these are impacted by religious beliefs Students know and understand alternative views and how ethical frameworks might impact on moral decisions Students will know and understand tier 3 vocabulary	Fluency test for vocabulary and key facts half way through the topic End of Unit exam focussing on vocabulary, key points of understanding and knowledge
EOY summative assessment	Students will demonstrate consolidated learning from the year in a formal assessment to take place in lesson. The assessment will have a mixture of multiple choice, short answer and longer answers questions with limited expectation on the ability to analyse and evaluate, the later skills will be developed and increase in importance as they move through KS3	Assessment focussed on short response and extended response from the Y9 curriculum, with particular focus on ethical issues and evaluative responses
