Unit 2 Islam	Students will know understand history and theology related to Islam which includes the debate around the beginning for Islam and the role of the prophet Muhammad (pbuh) Students will know and understand beliefs, teachings and practices from Islam Student will know and understand common misconceptions about Islam Students know and understand the concepts revelation, predestination, worship and the 5 pillars and importance for Muslims today Students will know and understand tier 3 vocabulary	Fluency test for vocabulary and key facts half way through the topic  End of Unit exam focussing on vocabulary, key points of understanding and knowledge
Unit 3 Philosophy	Students will know understand the concept of Philosophy and its role in Human history Students will know and understand some key philosophical approaches Student will know and understand common misconceptions about philosophy Students know and understand the concepts creation, justification, empirical evidence and purpose Students will know and understand tier 3 vocabulary	Fluency test for vocabulary and key facts half way through the topic  End of Unit exam focussing on vocabulary, key points of understanding and knowledge
EOY summative assessment	Students will demonstrate consolidated learning from the year in a formal assessment to take place in lesson. The assessment will have a mixture of multiple choice, short answer and longer answers questions with limited expectation on the ability to analyse and evaluate, the later skills will be developed and increase in importance as they move through KS3	Assessment focussed on short response and extended response from the Y8 curriculum, with particular focus on Islam and Christianity
